

## **Wild Chama Races**

### **Brazos Burnout – Risk Management Plan**

To ensure the safety of all participants, volunteers, and spectators, the following risk management protocols will be in place for the Wild Chama Races:

- **Waivers:** All participants, volunteers, and guardians (for minors) will be required to sign liability waivers prior to the event.
- **Medical Support:** Certified EMTs, trained in Search and Rescue, will be onsite for the duration of the race.
- **Course Support:** Roving support personnel will monitor the course to provide on-the-spot assistance as needed.
- **Aid Zone:** A designated food and water handoff zone will be provided. Potable water will be available and maintained by race organizers.
- **Hydration Requirement:** All racers will be required to carry water on their bike in order to participate.
- **Course Marshals:** Marshals will be stationed at intervals no greater than two miles apart. All marshal stations will be equipped with cell or radio communication to ensure full coverage and rapid response capability across the course.
- **Emergency Rerouting:** Certain roads and marked trail connectors allow for mid-race rerouting. Course marshals have the authority to instruct riders to take designated shortcuts if necessary for safety, medical reasons, or extreme fatigue.
